

ORDINANCE NO. 226

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF UNDERWOOD, IOWA, BY AMENDING PROVISIONS PERTAINING TO SEWER SERVICE CHARGE.

WHEREAS, the City of Underwood adopted Ordinance No. 225 at its monthly meetings of March 14, 2017, April 4, 2017, and May 9, 2017, and published on March 23, 2017; and

WHEREAS, said Ordinance No. 225 provided for the effective changes in sewer service charges under Section 99.02 of the City Code of Ordinances; and

WHEREAS, the table contained in Subsection (2) of Section 99.02 in Ordinance No. 225 contained typographical errors to the commercial sewer charge rate on the "First 2,000 gallons" for the years effective July 1, 2018, and effective July 1, 2019. Specifically, the effective rate for the first 2,000 gallons as of July 1, 2018, should be \$16.56 rather than \$21.60 and effective July 1, 2019, the effective rate should be \$18.55 rather than \$24.14; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to correct the typographical errors and adopt the table as set forth below.

BE it enacted by the City of Underwood, Iowa:

SUBSECTION AMENDED: Chapter 99, Section 02, Subsection (2) of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Underwood, Iowa, is hereby amended to read in full as follows:


2. Multi-dwelling, commercial and industrial property owners shall pay a monthly charge based upon the amount of water consumed as follows:

20,001 gallons and over	\$5.50 per 1,000 gallons	\$ 6.60 per 1,000 gallons	\$ 7.59 per 1,000 gallons	\$ 8.50 per 1,000 gallons
