<u>Call to Order:</u> Mayor Bardsley called the Regular Meeting to order on Tuesday, 12/14/2021 at 6 p.m.

Pledge of Allegiance: Recited by all.

**Approval of Agenda:** Madsen moved, Dose seconded to approve the agenda. Motion carried 4-0. No council member stated a conflict of interest with any agenda items.

<u>Approval of Minutes:</u> Forbush moved, Madsen seconded to approve the November 9, 2021, Regular Meeting minutes. Motion carried 4-0.

<u>Public Forum:</u> Tom Kallman, Regional Water Manager, introduced himself. He started one month ago. He intends to attend council meetings throughout the towns Regional Water services. Tom Kallman left at 6:22 p.m.

<u>Wastewater Treatment Plant (Jeff Godwin, P.E.):</u> Consensus from council to have the Engineer move forward with submission to the Iowa Department of Natural Resources for the Facility Plan for the WasteWater Treatment Plant upgrade.

<u>Watershed-Stormwater Pay Application #3 Approval:</u> Engineer provided a substantial completion date for the Watershed project. Madsen moved, Dose seconded to approve Pay App #3 to JNC Construction. Motion carried 4-0.

Watershed-Stormwater Project Change Order #3: Masen moved, Forbush seconded to approve Change Order #3 that provided a reduction of \$19,875.45 to the project. Motion carried 4-0. JNC is aware they need to come back in the spring to ensure grass has grown in the project area, since it fell outside of SUDAS dates. Jeff Godwin left at 6:26 p.m.
