Nate Summers discussed the GO Bonds and constitutional debt limit. With the addition of this GO Bond for Charles Drive, city is using 36% of debt capacity. Per Summers, no local banks responded to UMB inquiries 3 weeks ago. Cornerstone Bank in Clarinda did respond. Pingel moved, Forbush seconded to approve Resolution 22-11-12 Authorizing and Approving a Loan Agreement, Providing for the Placement and Issuance of General Obligation Corporate Purpose Bonds, Series 2022 and Providing for the Levy of Taxes to Pay the Same. Roll Call Vote: Forbush-Yes, Pingel-Yes, Madsen-Yes, Dose-Yes. Resolution adopted 4-0.

Dose moved, Forbush seconded to approve Personnel Committee Recommendation of hiring Justen Tooley, full-time Public Works assistant. Motion carried 4-0.

Forbush moved, Pingel seconded to adjourn the meeting. Motion carried 4-0. Mayor Bardsley adjourned the meeting at 1:15 p.m.
