Pottawattamie County Board of Supervisors Present \$125,000 forgivable loan to City of Underwood

On April 21, the Pottawattamie County Board of Supervisors presented the City of Underwood with a check for \$125,000.00

Waste Water Treatment Plant

The Iowa Department of Natural Resources is in the process of reviewing the lagoon system outfall to the creek. Once they notify the City of their findings, the new Wastewater Facility Plan, completed by Snyder and Associates Engineering firm, will be submitted according to DNR guidelines.

Thanks to the innovative idea of a community member, in conjunction with City Council, Underwood will have another sense of community spirit and pride.

BANNERS

Underwood - United and Unique!

A prototype banner arrived for testing. This mesh banner is to allow more wind through them to potentially withstand the winds better than the Vinyl butterfly banners. Vinyl, canvas and mesh banners allow for more graphic designs than the Sunbrella material which was used on the Underwood Logo, Winter and Patriotic banners.

The prototype is displayed on 3rd Street near the Elementary/Middle School. It will be moved soon by North Street and Faith Avenue, near the High School.

CHARLES DRIVE PROJECT

Bluffs Paving worked on Charles Drive late Fall/early Winter 2022. The road has a solid and strong base; and for the first time it has concrete. The road is now straight.

There are some cracks in the Right of Way newly poured concrete. Per SUDAS construction guidelines, the cracks will be filled with tar. The ditch has been regraded, seeded with grass and hydroseeded.

The contractor will be returning this summer to finish up any last items.

UNDERWOOD

GRASS CLIPPINGS DON'T BELONG IN THE STREET

Ordinance 135.03 PLACING DEBRIS ON

It is unlawful for any person to throw or deposit on any street or alley any glass, glass bottle, nails, tacks, wire, cans, trash, garbage, rubbish, litter, offal, **leaves, grass** or any other debris likely to be washed into the storm sewer and clog the storm sewer, or any substance likely to injury any person, animal or vehicle. (Code of lowa, Sec. 321.369)

The City does not have a dump. It is not allowed to place them in the North Street Ditch, nor North Street to Milwaukee, nor Charles Drive.

This clogs the storm sewers.

Yard Tags are for sale in packs of 5 to use with your existing bags. Weight limit 40 pounds. ***Yard Bags are for sale in packs of 5 as well. You can buy both at City Hall.

When walking with your dogs, please pick up after your pup. Please do not leave your dog's "poo" on city streets, right of ways, the parks, sidewalks, or fellow neighbors properties. Remember to take a plastic bag with you to transport it back home.
