Antidegradation Alternatives Analysis for the City of Underwood, Iowa

Notice Date: October 14, 2023

Notice is hereby given that the City of Underwood, Iowa has completed a draft antidegradation alternatives analysis for discharge of treated wastewater to Mosquito Creek. The action being considered is construction of a LemTec Biological Treatment Process to replace the existing aerated lagoon facility followed by ultraviolet disinfection. Mosquito Creek is protected for Class A1 primary contact recreational, Class B(WW-1) warm water beneficial, Class C raw water source for potable water, and Class HH waters with fish harvested for human consumption.

Anyone wishing to comment on the proposed treatment alternative must do so in writing within 30 days of the date shown at the top of this notice.
