

If a property owner doesn't remove the snow within a reasonable time, the city may do so and assess the cost against the property.





IOWA HOMEOWNER ASSISTANCE FUND



MORTGAGE HELP IS HERE FOR IOWA HOMEOWNERS

The Iowa Homeowner Assistance Fund program assists eligible Iowa homeowners in avoiding foreclosure by providing financial assistance with mortgage payments and related property expenses.

AMIELIGIBLE?

ELIGIBLE HOMEOWNERS MUST:

- · Be income qualified
- Have had someone in the household experience a financial hardship after January 21, 2020 because of the COVID-19 pandemic.
 - This could be the result of a reduction in income or increase in living expenses due to job loss, fewer work hours, paying more for childcare, illness, or being unable to work because you had to take care of a family member
- Be at least one payment behind on one of the following:
 - Mortgage
 - Contract sale, (purchasing a home under a legally recorded contract)
 - Manufactured home
 - Property taxes.
- Own the property located in Iowa (applicants purchasing a home under a legally recorded contract are eligible)
- · Occupy the home as their primary residence

WHAT TYPE OF ASSISTANCE IS AVAILABLE?

Up to \$25,000 per eligible household to assist with past due payments, including:

Eligible Past Due Expenses:



- · Mortgage Payments
- · Land contract sale payments
- Manufactured Hama/
 - · Manufactured Home/Lot Rent Payments
 - Property Taxes
 - Homeowner's Insurance (Homeowner's hazard, flood, and/or mortgage insurance)



· Homeowner Association Fees

WHAT DO I NEED TO DO TO APPLY?

Take the eligibility precheck at iowafinance.com/IHAF to determine preliminary eligibility.

Prepare required application documentation.

STEP Submit online application at iowafinance.com/IHAF

The mortgage servicer and/or other service providers of past due amounts will be required to verify the information submitted by the applicant.

TEP The case review team will review the application to ensure all documentation is complete and to verify eligibility.

In some cases, applicants will be referred to free, confidential mortgage counseling through lowa Mortgage Help to ensure housing stability prior to being eligible for financial assistance through the program.

WILL I RECEIVE PAYMENT DIRECTLY, IF APPROVED?

No. Payments will be made directly to mortgage servicers and other payees, as applicable to be applied to the homeowner's account(s).

Payment is due with your application. **No refunds** will be given. Applications are due by **June 1, 2024**. Any applications received after **June 1** will be assessed a late fee of \$15.00. Upon receiving your application fee, your spot as a vendor will be reserved and added to our Facebook page. Within two days of the event, all vendors will be notified of their space number and spot location.

FOOD VENDORS - be sure to have proof of your food license with the state. Food vendors will be located outside the main UMBA doors.

During the show, no parking in handicap designated areas or in front of storage units across from the UMBA's main doors.

SET-UP: Inside Vendors are encouraged to set up Friday, June 7. The UMBA building will be open from 6:00 p.m.- 9:00 p.m. Doors will be locked at 9:00 p.m. to secure your wares. If unable to set up on Friday evening, inside vendors may set up on Saturday from 6:00 a.m. to 7:30 a.m. All loading vehicles must be moved to a side street by 7:30 a.m. If your vehicle is still parked in front of UMBA or the handicap spots at 7:30 AM you will be required to move it and haul your items up from another location. THIS IS A MANDATORY GUIDELINE and will be strictly enforced for the safety of the crowds. Please provide your own tables. Two chairs will be provided for your spot.

Outside Vendors - please plan accordingly for the weather. Bring a canopy or tent for shade. Tent weights recommended. No tables provided. The show will go on rain or shine. Outside vendors may set up from 5:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m on Friday, June 7, or from 6:00 a.m. to 7:30 a.m. on Saturday, June 8. Setting up on Friday evening is at your own risk as no policing of the area will be provided. All loading vehicles must be moved from spaces by Saturday at 7:30 a.m. THIS GUIDELINE IS MANDATORY and will be strictly enforced for the safety of the crowds. No overnight staying allowed. Spaces are 20' wide and 12' deep (coming out from the sidewalk).

SPOTS: While we do our best to be accommodating, we cannot guarantee our vendors their spot from previous years. We will notify you at least two days prior to the event where your spot will be located.
