PUBLIC HEARING NOTICE

The City of Underwood will be holding a Public Hearing to review an application for a State Revolving Fund (SRF) loan and to make available to the public the contents of an environmental information document and the City of Underwood's project plan. These documents include design and environmental information related to the proposed improvements to the City's wastewater treatment system.

The proposed project includes the construction of improvements to the wastewater treatment system including approximately 1,000 linear feet of 12 inch sanitary sewer, flow measurement equipment, flow control equipment, manholes, blower building, UV disinfection, a LemTec Biological Treatment Process covered lagoon aeration system, and a diffuser outlet into Mosquito Creek. The proposed construction area is located within the current wastewater treatment system property.

The purpose of this Public Hearing is to inform area residents served by the City of Underwood Sewer Department of this proposed action, discuss the actual cost and user fees associated with this project, and to address citizen's concerns, if any, with the plan.
