#### Dear Underwood Neighbor:

The High School Junior Optimist International (JOI) Club and the Underwood Optimist Club are proud to again offer an annual subscription to celebrate six national holidays to line the streets with American Flags for \$40 per year in front of your home or business. We will place a 3'x5' American Flag on a pole on these national holidays: Memorial Day, Flag Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Patriot Day, and Veteran's Day. \*Please note, in case of severe weather (snow, ice, violent storms, or heavy rain), for the safety of our club members, we may not put out flags. Subscription service is limited to within the Underwood City limits.

Club volunteers will generally install the flags the night before and retrieve them after the holiday. We may leave flags up for more than the one day. A receptacle that remains will be installed approx. 3'-10' from the street in front of your home or business if you have not previously subscribed. The receptacle will be just above ground level with a red/colored cap so as not to interfere with normal mowing but is visible to us. If you can help us remove vegetation and debris around the cap it will help us greatly to find them. We will contact lowa One-Call, so utilities are not disturbed before placing new receptacles. We need approximately 2 weeks' notice to get the receptacle placed. Example: all subscriptions must be received by May 15 for Memorial Day.

Please consider buying a subscription to Avenue of Flags. If you would like to have more than one flag (add another subscription) at your home or business, you may do so. You may also want to donate a subscription to someone else's home or business (use a separate form for each address location).

All proceeds support the JOI High School and Underwood Optimist Clubs' activities and projects. In recent years JOI has been able to perform many community service projects, both groups provide graduating seniors with scholarships and allow many of our members to be able to attend International and State Optimist Conventions.

# YARD WASTE PROGRAM GUIDELINES

#### **SERVICES:**

Curbside Yard Waste Service Dates: April 1-October 31, 2025

Yard waste will be picked up the same days as recycling. (Yard waste must be at the curb the night before.)

# YARD WASTE TAGS

- Yard waste must be placed securely inside biodegradable yard waste bags. Yard waste in plastic bags will not be accepted.
- Garbage Company is not selling bags any longer, only TAGS.
- Bags must not weigh more than 40 pounds.
- Branches and brush must be placed in yard waste bags that you purchase on your own.
- Branches must be 2 inches in diameter or less. Bundles must not be more than 4 feet long and must not weigh more than 40 pounds.



# YARD WASTE IS DEFINED:

Grass, Leaves, Garden Waste, Twigs, Brush, and Branches 2 inches or smaller in diameter.

# UNACCEPTABLE MATERIAL:

Litter, Trash, Garbage

Street Sweepings, Sand

Kitty Litter, Pet Manure

Any of the above items co-mingled with yard waste

Un-bagged or unbundled items -Bags/ Bundles in excess of 40 pounds

Bundles over 4 feet in length / Branches over 2 inches in diameter

## WHAT TO USE

Please purchase bags of your choice, at a store, that are biodegradable.

There are no more bags sold by the garbage company.

You will need to purchase any "IWS" TAG to place on your biodegradable bags.

Tags may be purchased for \$8.75 per bundle of five

TAGS may be purchased at CITY HALL.

## Ordinance 135.03 PLACING DEBRIS ON

It is unlawful for any person to throw or deposit on any street or alley any glass, glass bottle, nails, tacks, wire, cans, trash, garbage, rubbish, litter, offal, **leaves, grass** or any other debris likely to be washed into the storm sewer and clog the storm sewer, or any substance likely to injury any person, animal or vehicle. (Code of Iowa, Sec. 321.369)

The City does NOT have a dump. Please do not dump at: North Street Ditch, nor North Street to Milwaukee, nor Charles Drive.

This CLOGS the storm sewers.
