<u>Approval of Agenda</u>: No council member stated a conflict of interest with any agenda items. Madsen moved, Erwin seconded to approve the agenda. Motion carried 5-0.

<u>Approval of Minutes:</u> Tiarks moved, Pingel seconded to approve the July 8, 2025, regular meeting minutes. Motion carried 5-0.

<u>Public Forum:</u> There was nothing brought up during public forum.

<u>Discuss/Action 2nd Reading and Waive 3rd Reading Amend Ordinance Increase - Garbage Rates No Recycling:</u> Madsen moved, Erwin seconded to approve the second reading of the amended ordinance for garbage collection rate increase with no recycling and waive the third reading. Motion carried 5-0.
