



Snow Removal for Streets

Per City Ordinance, all vehicles need to be off streets by 3 AM the morning of the snow.



Snow Removal for Sidewalks

Per Chapter 136.03, Snow must be removed from sidewalks promptly. If a property owner doesn't remove the snow with in a reasonable time, the city may do so and assess the cost against the property.

We would like to remind citizens to clear sidewalks as well as moving their cars as needed to help with the snow removal process. It is a big process to completely remove the snow from the streets so please be respectful and let us know if there are any issues or concerns.

Friendly reminder to citizens with Basketball Hoops in the street, when SNOW FLIES- Please remove the basketball hoops from the street for ease of snow removal.

Licensing your Dog for 2026



Dog licenses are due annually. Intact dog is \$20.00 per dog, spade or nuetered dog is \$10.00 per dog. Beginning 3/1/2026, there will be a late fee for \$10.00 per dog.

There are multiple ways you can get the dog license application (Single 1-dog or Multi-dog-up to 3 max per city ordinance.)

- · Go to www.underwoodia.com and print the dog license application.
- · Complete the fillable dog license application on the city website, print or save and email to the City.
- · There is also the availability of using Front Desk.
- · Come to city hall to complete in-person at city hall

A <u>current rabies certificate</u> signed by a veterinarian must be attached. Once reviewed by staff, you can either pay via Front Desk or drop a check in the drop box or in person.

Again, a reminder that a dog licenses cannot be issued unless the rabies vaccine is current and not expiring within 30 days.
